Flutist Natasha Loomis is a versatile and engaging performer of music from Baroque to contemporary. An avid chamber musician and passionate proponent of new music, Natasha has performed throughout the United States, as well as in France, Austria, and Peru, and at a diverse range of New York City area venues, including Weill Recital Hall at Carnegie Hall and Alice Tully Hall. Recent engagements include the XXXII Festival Internacional de Flautistas in Lima, Peru, where she was a guest artist and clinician, and Lake Tahoe Music Festival Orchestra in California. She will be performing Howard Hanson's Serenade with the New Brunswick Chamber Orchestra this May.
